Syncarpha Solar is the company putting the solar project in and asked Randy if the town would consider/agree to some form of decommissioning bond proof or alternative escrow account instead of them having to start the project before winter. Randy and the Select Board discussed it and decided it is a reasonable request the Select Board asked Randy to find out the numbers (amounts) they are willing to put into escrow account. Randy said he will email/ talk to them and notify \*STTS\* Aimee Nelson what they say and Aimee will inform the Select Board at the next meeting and then the Select Board will give their final decision.
