1. Generator for Town Office- Tabled
2. FEMA approved projects email- The Town of Troy received an email update on the paperwork breakdown for the December 22-23, 2022 storm.
3. Town of Troy Insurance- The Select Board reviewed and signed the paperwork.
4. Tree Growth Penalty- The Select Board reviewed and signed the Tree Growth Penalty.
5. Bulky Waste Dates- Bulky Waste dates for the 2024 are May 11, 2024 and September 14, 2024.
6. Sargent- Sargent sent the town a 2024 contractor customer price list for the aggregate materials from the Plymouth quarry.
7. Waldo County Tax- The Town of Troy received the new Waldo County tax bill. The Town of Troy portion is \$169,220.70. It is an increase of \$30,253.62 from last year.
8. Town Warrant- Treasurer Aimee Nelson will have the warrant ready soon for the Select Board to review. Guest, Alec Reynolds II asked the Select board if they have looked into how much it will be to remove the BB Cook building. The Select board responded no they want to wait until town meeting and let the town residents vote (decide) on what is going to happen.
9. Office closed- March 5, 2024 for the Presidential Primary Election.
10. Town Meeting Article- The Select Board reviewed the response from the lawyer on the article for the town meeting warrant. The Select Board asked \*STTS\* Aimee Nelson to review the way the BB Cook funds were set up and what the funds can be used for.
11. Pine Tree Waste Services- The Town of Troy received a request from Pine Tree Waste Service (trash dumpster pickup company) for permission to use posted roads for the 2024 season. The Select Board approved the request.
12. Historical Society- Chair, Sandy Olson of the Historical Society called the town office and asked \*STTS\* Aimee Nelson to ask the Select Board if they would approve a request for \$800.00 to have someone paint the

town office to ask to void the tree growth penalty. He will also be doing a new tree growth harvest plan. The Select Board reviewed and approved the request.

6. Planning Board Oath- The Select Board approved Aimee Nelson becoming an Alternate Planning Board member
7. Roads- The Select Board discussed the roads in town. Selectman, Brian Piper drove around with Dennis Jones. The frost will be out of the dirt roads soon and then Dennis will start bringing stone in for the problem areas. Selectperson, Richard Montana called Toby Farrington (he graded the roads in Troy) and asked him to put Troy on the list to get the roads graded.
8. Direct Communications- Direct Communications emailed the town office that the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) is doing away with the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) and the town will lose the discount it has been receiving starting in April. \*STTS\* Aimee Nelson will call and get more information about it.
9. FEMA- The town of Troy has received it first payment fro, the December 2022 storm, \$27,874.39.
