The state of Maine DOT responded to her in an email that the town needs to request a speed study. *STTS* Aimee Nelson contacted Peter Coughlan, Director of Local Roads and he emailed that the town could request a speed study but to be careful cause the speed limit could be increased and recommended that the town requested slow down and corner signs (signage) be put up instead. The Select Board discussed it and agreed to the signs. *STTS* Aimee Nelson will contact DOT and request signs be put up on the Burnham Road.
3. Winslow Community Cupboard- The Winslow Community Cupboard emailed a request to the town for a donation (they asked for the town to use ARPA funds).
