Bruce Cook: Bruce Cook representing Unity Ambulance presented to the Select Board the new direction of the company. At this time Unity Ambulance is trying to eliminate volunteers and go to full-time employees with set schedules. The ambulance office is equipped for those on 24 hours on call status, with places to sleep and prepare meals. At this time it is projected to have per diem positions until benefits can be offered. Bruce went on to explain that this is a process that will need financial backing from those hopefully surrounding Towns to step forward and help make this happen. Bruce explained that due to being a small ambulance and only having around 600 calls per year the company does not qualify for ICSD state allocated funds. Bruce is asking each town that he is visiting for the Select Boards help in finding a town resident who might want to be on the Unity Ambulance Committee that is in the process of being formed. The Select Board discussed it and asked *STTS* Aimee Nelson to ask Shawn Quimby if he would be on the committee.

1. Town Office floors/ paint- Shawn Quimby will be finishing the painting and doing the floors at the town office building starting October 9, 2024. The Select Board agreed to the office being closed on Wednesday, October 9, 2024 and Thursday, October 10, 2024 so the work can be done.
