There were two proposals (Waldo County Oil and Fabian) for putting in a propane tank and hooking it all up. The Select Board reviewed the proposals and decided on Waldo County Oil. The town is going to own the tank and will call around to find out what company has the best price before they are filled. All of this getting done will hinge on the Special Town Meeting and the town approving the funds.
3. General Assistance- The Town Office had an inspection from the State of Maine General Assistance Program Specialist, David Bailey. David inspected the building to verify the town is in compliance with the General Assistance statues (a copy of the General Assistance Ordinance is available for viewing, the contact information for General Assistance is posted, etc.) The town is in compliance.
