- C. Guest:** Travis Sullivan attended the Select Board meeting to discuss sand with the Select Board. In the plow contract the sand is supplied from the contractor. Travis asked if he could use the town pit for mixing the salt/ sand and also used the sand from the pit. The sand in the pit is better quality than what Travis is seeing around. Travis will pay the town of Troy \$3.00 a yard for any sand that he uses. The Select Board discussed it and said as long as the sand is good and Travis pays the town of Troy for the sand and the town of Troy is not responsible for any of his equipment that he has there. Everyone agreed to the terms.

2. Fuel Bids- All paperwork has been sent out and bids will be opened at the Select Board meeting on April 2, 2025.
3. Barker Road- Selectperson, Thomas Byron went out and looked at the reported tree on 66 Barker Road, the tree is not close enough to the road that the town takes care of it. \*STTS\* Aimee Nelson will notify the property owner it is there reasonable to take care of the tree.

**E. New Business:**

1. February Bank Statement Breakdown- The Select Board reviewed and initialed the February bank statement breakdown.
2. February Sub Accounting Breakdown- The Select Board reviewed and initialed the February bank statement breakdown.
3. Waldo County Tax- On February 6, 2025 the town of Troy received the Waldo County Tax Bill. Troy's portion was \$196,776.66 that was an increase of \$27,555.96 from last year. On March 13, 2025 the Town of Troy received an updates county tax bill for the amount of \$185,086.17 that is an increase of \$15,865.47 from last year.
4. Donation Request- \*STTS\* Aimee Nelson discussed with the Select Board a situation that happened at town meeting. When the donation articles were being discussed a resident want to give Unity Library a donation, Aimee said that it couldn't happen because they didn't not collect the required signature (in 1998 it was voted

on and approved at town meeting that anyone asking for donations has to collect 25 registered signatures). The resident pushed it through anyway. Aimee said that wasn't fair and other companies had asked for donations and were told they have to do the required signatures. The Select Board discussed the situation and asked Aimee to contact legal about if the donation needs to be given (they don't think it should be) since it was voted on but it is against what the town requirements are.

5. ATV- The Select Board discussed letting the ATVs use the roads year round. The Select Board decided that the roads are for access to the trails and they should not be on the roads when the trails are closed.
6. Bolster's Rubbish Removal- The Select Board reviewed the email from Bolsters requiring why some of the garbage in town isn't picked up (no stickers, weight).
7. Oaths- The Select Board reviewed and approved the oaths.
8. Maine Local Roads- Speed Trailer Loan Program- The Select Board reviewed the paperwork.
9. Stream Smart- The Select Board reviewed the paperwork.
10. Overhead Door- Sand Shed Door- Tabled until the Select Board can review the condition.
11. Certified Ratio Declaration- Assessor, Josh Morin from Hamlin Associates filled out the paperwork and email it to the Select Board for review. The Select Board reviewed the paperwork.
