**D. Old Business:**

1. Bulky Waste Day- Bolsters Rubbish Removal and the Troy Select Board signed the contracts. May 3, 2025 and September 13, 2025 are the dates.

1. Roads- The Select Board discussed the upcoming roadwork.
2. Donation- The Troy Volunteer Fire Department has been offered a 6X6 Army style truck. It would be able to go off road easier for forest fires. The truck will need will need to have a 5,000 gal water tank added to it. Selectperson, Richard Montana informed the Select Board the Fire Department said the truck will not cost the town any funds, everything is being donated (Fire Chief, Chris Phillips will donated the tank and Fire fighter, Josh Mitchell will donate the lights and radio). The Select Board discussed it and had a few questions. \*STTS\* Aimee Nelson will get the answers to the questions for the next Select Board meeting. The Select Board decided to table it until the next meeting.
3. Map 8 Lot 28- A resident owns the property and no longer wants it. The property is .07 acres. The Select Board discussed it and decided they do not want to take ownership of the property. The property has other issues the property owner needs to address.
4. Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event- KVCOG is having a Hazardous waste event, In the past Troy did sign up for the events (and pay for it) but stopped participation in the events (no one from town was using the collection event). One resident in town contacted \*STTS\* Aimee Nelson and asked about it. Aimee contacted KVCOG and they agreed the resident could go and pay on their own and the town does not have to participate in the event. The Select Board agreed with the idea.
5. MMA Executive Committee Ballot- The Select Board discussed it and voted.
6. RSU#3 Letter-The Select Board reviewed the letter.
7. DOT Bridge Inspection- The Select Board reviewed the report. The report states there are some issues with the guardrails. The Select Board will stop and view the damage and discuss it at the next meeting.
